QUEEN CONTEST RULES

QUEENS MUST REPRESENT THE AHSI RIDING A PUREBRED/PARTBRED ARABIAN

MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

Queen contestants must be paid members of AHSI by the first show of the year.

First show of 2019 is: May 5, at Elkhart, Iowa (Prairie Rose Arena)

They must maintain their membership throughout their entire reign.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Junior Queen: 10 - 15 years old as of January 1 of the following year.

Senior Queen: 16 - 26 years old as of January 1 of the following year.

RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Queens must supply AHSI with a quality picture for publicity purposes.
2. Write at least a 200 word essay on how being involved with horses made you a more responsible person and how it helped you grow as an individual. Send it to Paula Straight by September 15. Winners will be published in the AHSI newsletter.
3. Represent at the Iowa State Fair Queen Contest.
4. Must get 1 sponsor (Approximately \$75. to \$100.) for the High Point program.
5. Help at the High Point Christmas Party.
6. Ride as AHSI Queen in parades etc., when possible.
7. Attend meetings when possible to help with club events.
8. All girls may compete every year they are eligible, including past Queens.
